Over the last twenty years, Kerala has experienced a significant influx of migrant laborers from states like Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Bengal, Assam, and others. Many of these migrants have chosen to settle in the Malappuram district, leading to a sense of alienation in this unfamiliar land. Language poses the most considerable barrier, contributing to their feeling of detachment. Fondly referred to as "guest laborers" in Kerala, there was a growing recognition that helping these workers gain functional knowledge of Malayalam would foster better relationships with the native community. Moreover, it was believed that acquiring proficiency in the language would improve their economic and social prospects. To address this issue, the college's Department of Malayalam took the initiative to design a comprehensive plan known as "Madhuram Malayalam." The program aimed to impart the necessary Malayalam language skills to the migrant laborers effectively. The IQAC meeting held on 08/10/2016 endorsed the implementation of this program in collaboration with the Department of Malayalam. The official announcement of the program was made during the 43rd anniversary of the parent institution and was officially launched on 03/01/2017.

The Department of Malayalam designed a special syllabus for the program, emphasizing a communicative approach to language teaching, with a focus on speaking and reading skills. They also incorporated vocabulary related to the labourers' specific areas of work, ensuring its practical relevance. Throughout the syllabus preparation process, Malayalam scholars and subject experts from the vicinity were consulted, ensuring its accuracy and effectiveness.
