EDUCATIONAL SURVEY IN THE SC COLONY





The Unit singled out Panthara village of Karuvarakundu Panchayath (one of the worst affected villages in 2019) as the site. Many houses in the area were devastated or defiled due to incessant rain and landslide. The Programme Officer Muhammed Musthefa coordinated the whole activities of cleaning. 29 volunteers, both boys and girls took part in the activity. The volunteers came to the campus with cleaning materials available at home, and set out from the college at 8.30 am. They spend a whole day cleaning and sanitizing around 10 houses.
